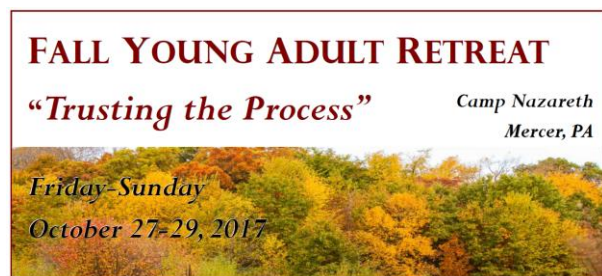
PARISH COUNCIL MEETING
