ANNUNCIATION CATHEDRAL COMMUNITY NATIVITY PSALTER GROUPS

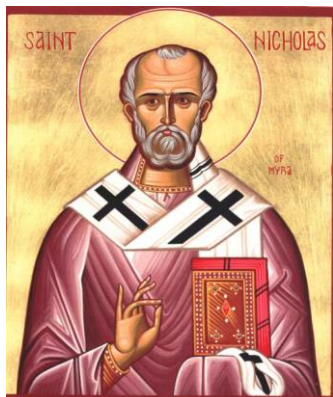


NOVEMBER 15, 2018

The Annunciation Greek Orthodox Cathedral again invites everyone to join our Psalter Group for the Nativity Lenten period beginning Thursday, November 15, 2018. Everyone will be assigned to a group of 20 fellow parishioners. The entire Book of Psalms is read every day within each psalter group as each of the 20 members read one of the 20 Kathismata of the Psalter. After each daily reading (which you do privately and at any time of the day you chose), each member says a prayer for the other members in their group and for our church. It is a beautiful way to focus our hearts and minds on Christ during this Lenten Season, pray as a community and move further toward becoming *of like mind and spirit*. All you need is your Bible or a Psalter and the commitment of 20 minutes a day. Psalter Books are available at our church Bookstore. Our goal of course is to have every parish member participating in the Psalter Reading. This is our seventh Community Psalter Group and we grow every year. We hope you will join us this year!

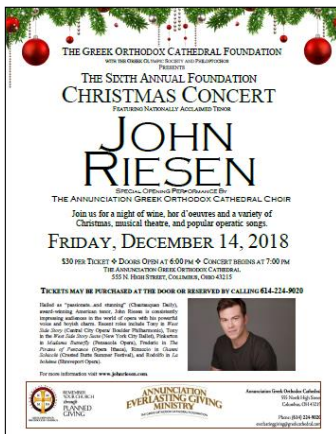

CATHEDRAL FOUNDATION – 6TH ANNUAL FOUNDATION CHRISTMAS CONCERT



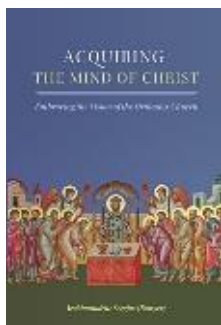
